Mrs. Clark updated the Board on her plans for Summer School and the additional needs of staff to help with student learning loss in the month of June, but to also establish a summer enrichment program in the month of July not limited to gifted classes, vocational classes, and physical activity classes, etc. These classes could be 1-4 weeks long. She anticipates the district will also be providing transportation. These costs will be paid out of ESSER Grant funds.

Mrs. Clark informed the Board that new curriculum is being reviewed for many grades/courses at this time for school year 2021-2022. Additionally, we will not be exempt from state testing and there has been a very good response from parents, staff and students on the 5 Essentials Survey.

Mrs. Clark updated the Board on the plans for the 2021-2022 school year with students attending full time, five days a week. A doctor's note will be required for a student to work remotely. It is her hope to have the Board to approve a Student Support Teacher in the future to work exclusively with all remote students K-12.
