

## Meals/Charge Policy

The Johnston City Community Unit School District #1 participates in the National School Lunch Program sponsored by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) which permits the school system to offer free and reduced priced meals to students who qualify. The Johnston City School District cannot permit excessive and reoccurring charges of meals. Customers may, however, pay for meals in advance.

Families who wish to apply for free or reduced meals must complete an application each year. The family of any DHS student may submit an application at any time during the school year. Applications are available in each school's office, or on the district website (located under online registration). Applicants are responsible for meals until a free or reduced application is completed and approved.

Full student breakfast - \$1.65. Full student lunch - \$2.15. Reduced student breakfast - \$0.30. Reduced student lunch - \$0.40 cents for all students in grades K-12. Extra milk - \$0.30. Adult breakfast - \$1.85; lunch - \$2.65. Monthly menus will be sent home with the child and will also be available through the school's web-site at [www.jcindians.org](http://www.jcindians.org).

**Meal charges** are permitted as follows for all Johnston City Community Unit School District #1 students:

- All elementary/middle school and high school students will be allowed to charge up to \$20.00 on their lunch account (this includes both breakfast and lunch charges).
- **Students are not allowed to charge ala carte or extra servings.**
- After the student has incurred charges of \$20.00, the student will have a lunch meal choice of **deli** sandwich, fresh fruit/vegetable, and white milk and a breakfast choice of cereal, toast, fresh fruit and white milk. This will meet the reimbursable meal option.
- Parents will be allowed to prepay meals and put money on their child's account by sending cash, check, or using a credit card online.

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
