



#### CHRISTMAS SAVINGS ACCOUNT

Christmas Savings Accounts are a great way to put aside money dedicated to your Christmas shopping. Accounts are commonly offered through credit unions or community banks. Deposits typically start in October to withdraw the following October. If you deposit \$20/week, you will have a check for \$1,040 for Christmas shopping. If Christmas time "surprises" you every year, consider this type of savings account to relieve the stress from Christmas/holiday shopping.



Thanks to the Election Day Holiday Act of 2021, Election Day is now a state holiday. For us, this means no school on Tuesday, November 8th, and those 18 and older can vote. Governor JB Pritzker signed senate bill 825, which changed many things for this election year. He praised it, saying, "It articulates the rights of Illinois citizens to vote by mail, allow those that are awaiting trial to cast their ballots, and makes a state holiday of Election Day." -Libby White

Ava Simmons was nominated by Mr. Clark. "She is a great kid and always does what she Is supposed to do."


Gavin Trimble was nominated by Mrs. Cockburn ."Gavin is a student who is always polite to others. He always tries to do his best in everything he does."
